

Louisiana Supersearch (LASS)

Automated reach. Human verification. Court-level accuracy.

The Louisiana Supersearch (LASS) searches District Courts across 35 parishes simultaneously, covering more than 85% of the state's population. Potential records are QA'd by expert researchers and returned in one consolidated, FCRA-compliant report. No private databases used. No separate parish follow-up orders needed.

Parallel Searches

District Courts searched in 35 parishes for broad coverage.

Automation + Expert Review

Automated case retrieval followed by researcher verification on every hit for IDs, accuracy, and reportability.

Court-Level Confirmation

Confirmed records include case number, court, charge level, dates, disposition, sentencing, and full identifiers.

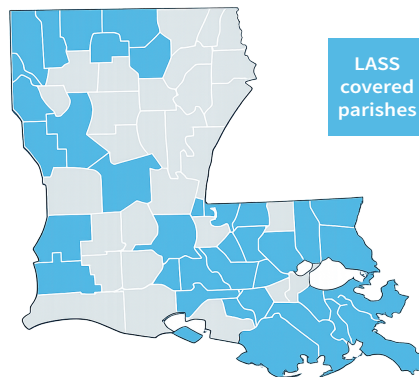
