

Massachusetts Supersearch (MASS)

All courts. All counties. No private databases.

The Massachusetts Supersearch (MASS) combines direct courthouse searches across every Massachusetts Superior and District trial court into one consolidated statewide report, with potential records reviewed for identifiers, accuracy, and reportability. MASS relies exclusively on direct court access—no private databases are used.

In-Person PAT Access

PATs must be accessed in person. Every terminal provides statewide court access.

84 Individual Court Searches

Researchers run a separate search for each Superior and District trial court to complete the statewide search.

Court-Level Confirmation

Confirmed records include case number, court, charge level, key dates, disposition, sentencing, & all readily available identifiers.

Massachusetts CORI Repository

- ☐ Standard employer CORI searches generally return only convictions and open cases
- ☐ Case information may be incomplete or lack key reporting details
- ☐ Limited detail can require additional court follow-up
- ☐ Requires CORI registration and compliance with DCJIS policies

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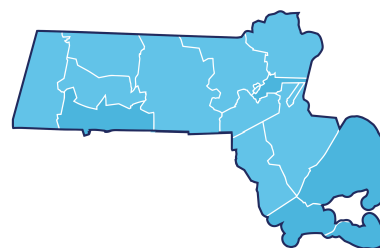
- ☒ Includes reportable non-convictions within 7 years by file date
- ☒ Full court-level case information retrieved directly from the courthouse
- ☒ Court-level verification performed for every record found - no follow-up needed
- ☒ No CORI registration or CORI-specific authorization process

10 years: felony/misdemeanor convictions
7 years by file date: non-convictions
